

➔ CONTAINER SEALING

After having stuffed the container and made sure before closing the doors that their free movement has not been impeded by the loading, the shipper is advised to seal the container.

The seal can be affixed on the soldered pieces, in which the door handles engage, articulated on the door lock bars.

The choice of seal is important :

- the simple, flat, metal seal offering little resistance and therefore little guarantee ;
- more efficient, the cylindrical seal with inserted number on its end.

While there is no absolutely unbreakable seal, every mean has to be taken to hamper or completely prevent - if possible - the opening of container in transit.

The haulier should indicate the seal number on the invoice and on any other document emitted from then on.
